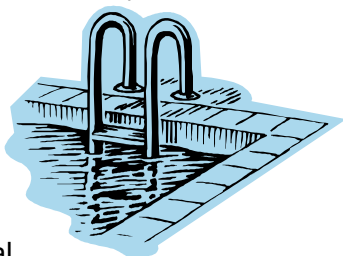

Pool & Spa Operator's Certification

This course is designed to provide guidelines for the safe operation of swimming pools and spas. As more swimming and specialized aquatic facilities are built there is an increasing need for professionally trained operators. These operator's must have the technical knowledge and practical experience necessary to fulfill these requirements. Pool owners, managers, and maintenance personnel are encouraged to attend. All public pools and spas in Fayette County are required by regulation to have at least one certified pool operator on duty during the hours of operation, but you may certify as many as you wish.
