PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING ANIMAL BITES

■ Under KRS 258.065 all incidents involving persons bitten by animals must be reported to the Health Department within twelve (12) hours after the physician's first attendance. The information that is to be reported is at the bottom of this page and in the adjacent column. If the person bitten does not know the name and address of the animal owner, you may instruct them to find out and call the Health Department as soon as possible with the information.

■ Do not mail this form to the Health Department; telephone or fax the information as soon as possible. Call the Health Department at: (859) 231-9791 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Our fax number is: (859) 231-9459. Bites occurring after hours or on weekends or holidays should be reported to the on-call Environmental Officer by calling (859) 252-2371.
