Surplus Property Declaration

During the normal course of operations, as a public agency, the Lexington Fayette County Health Department (hereafter referred to as "LFCHD") has the need to procure normal replacement products and equipment when items cease being useful to the agency and rather than storing the property for an indefinite period of time, it is in the best interest of the public to dispose of the products or goods in a transparent manner through a declaration of such items as surplus and subsequent disposal process.

The following items of property are no longer useful to LFCHD and are being declared as surplus and each will be offered for sale by sealed bid to the general public if approved by the BOH Finance Committee.

Item #1:

2007 Ford Ranger, 54,710 miles. White in color, 2 door, 6 cylinder. Due to the age of the vehicle, it was necessary to replace with a newer model for safety and to preserve professionalism for all for LFCHD staff. The vehicle is no longer in use by LFCHD. (See pictures attached)

Item #2:

2005 Cummins 480 Volt 3 Phase Unit, Model DGDK 5732048C Generator. This unit has not been used in four years. LFCHD upgraded to a larger unit for additional capacity to meet the needs of the agency. (See pictures attached)

Item #3

2006 Chevrolet Silverado 2500H, 24,836 miles. White in color. The vehicle will not turn on, does not run and is known to have severe rust throughout. Due to the age and condition of the vehicle, it was necessary to replace with a newer model for safety. (See pictures attached)
